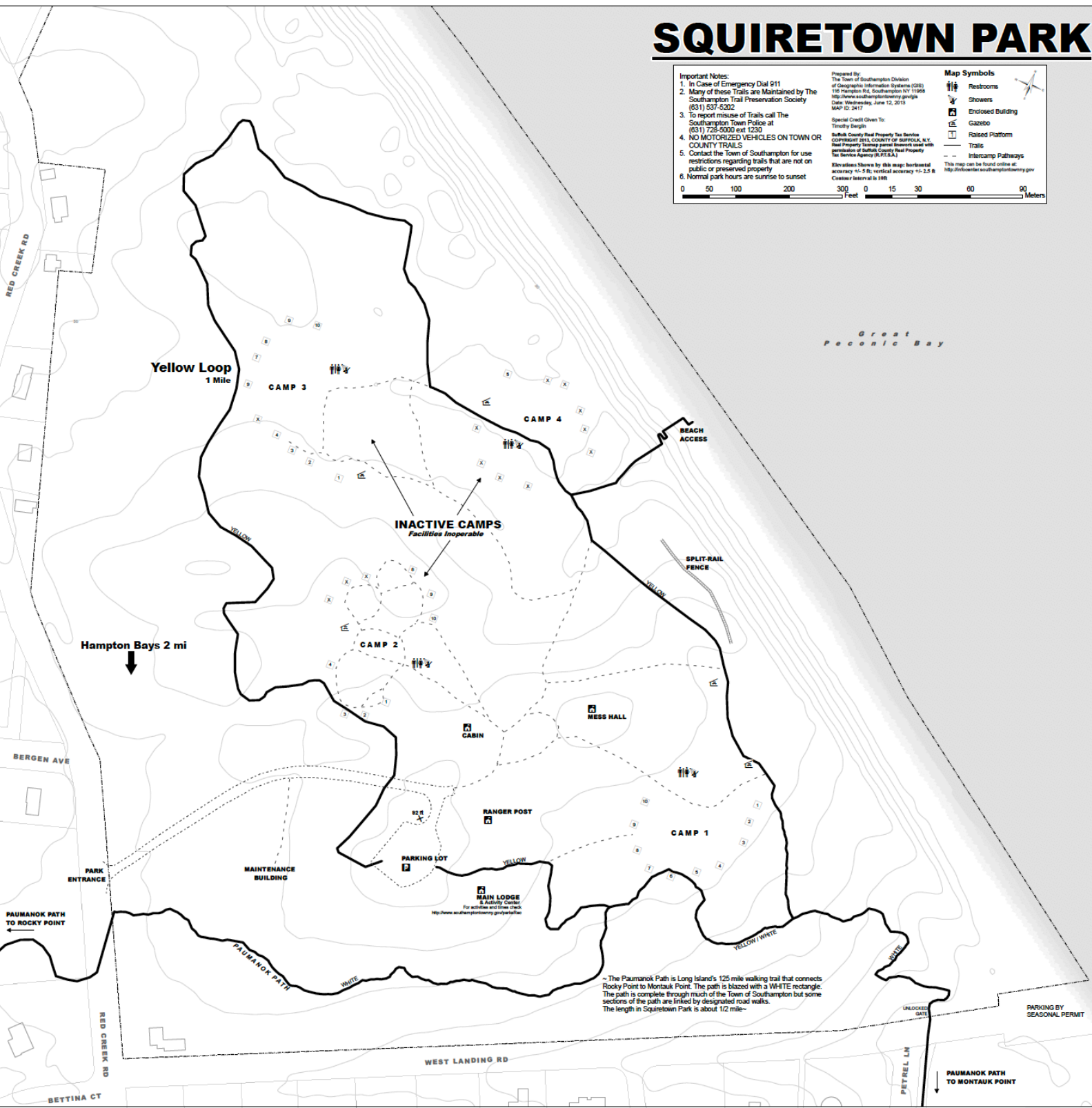

The path is complete through much of the Town of Southampton but some sections of the path are linked by designated road walks. The length in Squiretown Park is about 1/2 mile~
